Now is the time to make sure you are registered to vote! You must be registered to vote by October 11, 2022 to be ready to vote in the general election on November 8, 2022.



Are you registered? Using the camera on your smart phone, scan this QR code to check if you are registered to vote.



Not registered? Scan this QR code to access the Texas Voter Registration Application.

Complete your application by following these easy directions:

1. Review the application carefully when filling it out:

a. Write legibly.

b. Choose an option for all four questions under part 1.

c. Your residence (#3) is where you live. Your mailing address (#4) is where you receive mail. If these are the same, you can write "same" for part 4.

d. If this is your first time registering to vote in Texas, you can write "N/A" in part 5.

e. You must sign and date the application including writing out 2022 as the year.

2. Stamp and envelope needed!

Print form and address envelope to registrar address indicated in the top right of the printed form. Place the form in the closest United States Postal Service mailbox.

3. Confirm your voter registration
